

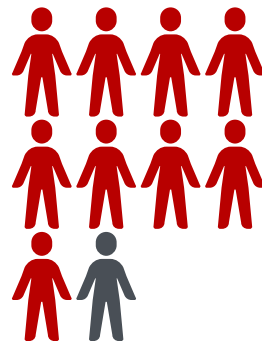
# 2022 Impact Report

In 2022, RED continued to create innovative and impactful evidencebased curriculum and restorative justice programming that increased our participants' social, civic, financial and digital literacy creating new lives with admirable aspirations and attainable goals.

## Overall Program Effectiveness

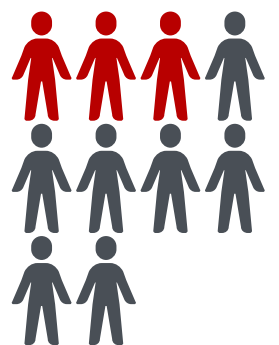
Less than 10% of RED's graduates reoffend and return to the criminal justice system compared to the greater than 65% of Georgians who reoffend after traditional adjudication.

## 2022 Program Retention

**18 of 21 participants** in our Gwinnett County Restorative Justice cohort **completed and graduated** from the 12-month program.

## Education & Certifications

All 18 graduates had a **H.S. Diploma or a GED** by program completion.

All 18 graduates received a **CPR Basic Skills Certification** by program completion.

All 18 graduates are **registered to vote**.



### First Year in Gwinnett County

We launched our inaugural cohort in Gwinnett County in 2022 with 21 participants. The success of the program has led to a request from Gwinnett County to expand the size of our cohorts as well as the total number of cohorts per year.

### Dollars Saved by Gwinnett County & Taxpayers in 2022

\* RED saves taxpayers in participating counties over \$20k per program graduate.

\* Each RED graduate produces \$22,129 benefit to the State of Georgia.

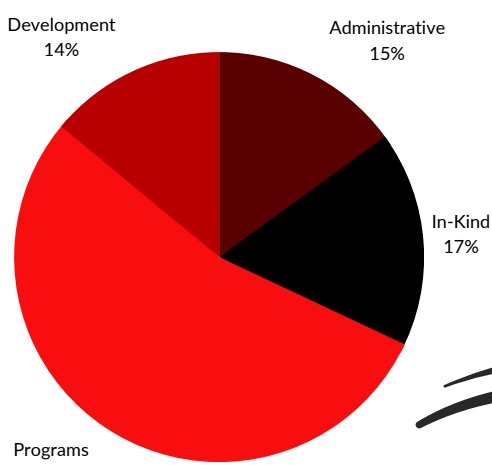
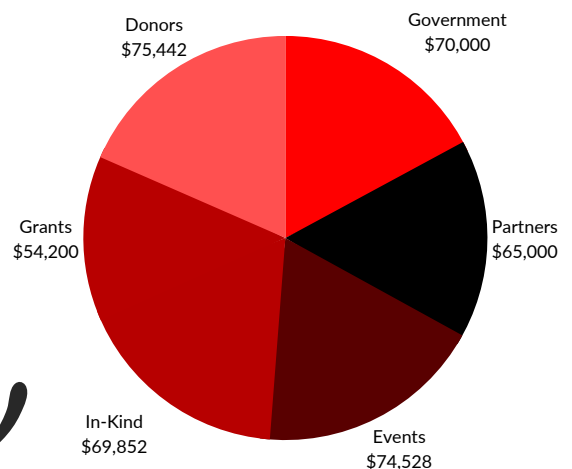
Whether it's through our transformative education programs or our unwavering advocacy for justice, we are dedicated to reaching as many people as possible and fostering a brighter future for all.
