In 2022, RED continued to create innovative and impactful evidencebased curriculum and restorative justice programming that increased our participants' social, civic, financial and digital literacy creating new lives with admirable aspirations and attainable goals.

### Overall Program Effectiveness

Less than 10% of RED's graduates reoffend and return to the criminal justice system compared to the greater than 65% of Georgians who reoffend after traditional adjudication.


18 of 21 participants in our **Gwinnett County Restorative Justice** cohort completed and graduated from the 12-month program.

Whether it's through our transformative education programs or our unwavering advocacy for justice, we are dedicated to reaching as many people as possible and fostering a brighter future for all.


### **Counties Impacted**



Increase of 6% over 2021.






#### 2022 Expense Financials
